- 26.2 It was noted that 391st EC under item No. 6 decided as under
 - a) PCI has considered 209 institutions covered under Hon'ble Supreme Court judgement dt.21.10.2022 in W.P. No.888/2022 filed by N.K. College of Pharmacy Vs. others.
 - b) 209 institutions are those institutions which were applied in the year 2020-2021 based on interim judgement passed by various High Courts across the India. However, PCI had imposed moratorium from 2020-2021 for opening of new D.Pharm and B.Pharm institutions in those states wherever number of pharmacy institutions were more than 50.
 - c) Hon'ble Supreme Court vide judgment dt.31.5.2022 has quashed the moratorium and directed the PCI to consider all the new institutions covered under the above judgement.
 - d) out of 209 institutions, most of the institutions not applied online during 2022-2023 academic session. Hence online decisions could not be conveyed to those institutions.
 - e) these institutions are moving to the courts stating that they are existing institutions of PCI but unable to apply on PCI portal.
 - f) The PCI has already requested number of times to Mr.Rajsekhar to open the portal for 209 institutions which was not yet opened.
 - g) these are existing institutions and they have to apply in 2023-2024 academic session for extension of approval.
 - h) the PCI portal for existing institutions was opened from 3.2.2023 to 20.2.2023 and further extended till 27.2.2023. (These 209 institutions were unable to apply when portal was opened).

In view of above, the EC decided to -

- a) open the portal for five working days for 209 institutions (existing instts) to avoid any contempt in the court
- b) write to institutions that it is the last opportunity and no further chance will be given.
- 26.3 It was further noted that after approval from competent authority, Google link was issued to 209 institutions which were unable to apply in the portal. In response, the PCI has received 94 applications.

- 31.3 Regarding D.Pharm course, it was noted that as per Item No.4 of 391 EC (5.3.2023), EC has already extended approval for D.Pharm course for 2023-2024 academic session for 60 intake.
- 31.4 Regarding B.Pharm course, institution has applied for introduction of new B.Pharm course from 2023-2024 academic session. Institution has submitted letter dt.27.2.2023 of Magadh University which states that University will be granted consent of affiliation of Examining Authority if PCI gives approval to institution. PCI vide letter dt.31.5.2023 has given 7 days of time to the institution for submission of consent of affiliation of Examining Authority and NOC of the State Government.
- 31.5 On receipt of compliance, the matter be placed before Executive Committee.
- 31.6 It was further decided to take action in anticipation of comments from the EC members on the EC minutes.
